### What Is Financial Aid?

Financial aid is money from the Department of Education to help pay for college.

### **Financial Aid Steps:**

- Step 1 Complete the "Free Application for Federal Student Aid" also known as the FAFSA <u>studentaid.gov</u>.
- Step 2 Schedule a financial aid follow-up appointment.
- Step 3Complete required documents and make your down payment(if applicable) before the first day of class.

#### **Independent Student**

- ✓ 24 Or Older
- Married
- ✓ Children Or Other Legal Dependent

### Dependent Student

- Under 24
- Not Married
- ✓ No Children Or Legal Dependent

\* Dependent students are required to use their parent's information to complete the FAFSA.

\* There may be other circumstances that could qualify you for Independent Status. Your Financial Aid Officer will review your dependency and eligibility with you during your Financial Aid Follow-up Appointment.
